PARENT GUIDE

Programme

Residential guests should arrive on Sunday at approx. 16.00 and 17.00 hrs and depart or be collected on Saturday at 10.00 hrs. The riding programme takes place from Monday to Friday. Those staying over the weekend may enjoy one extra day's riding programme on either Saturday or Sunday. The other weekend day includes an excursion to an historic town, a shopping centre, a theme park, nature reserve, horse trials or horse show. The transport costs are included in the extra charge for the weekend, but guests will be required to pay any entrance fees arising. We will schedule whether these activities will take place on Saturday or Sunday, and will choose the venue for the excursion taking into account the wishes of our guests as far as possible. The extra days/nights charge is applied when those travelling from overseas are unable to arrive or depart on Sunday and Saturday respectively.

Insurance

It is essential that clients are covered by a fully comprehensive activity holiday insurance. Unfortunately we can no longer provide this for you. When considering your insurance, please ensure that horse riding, including jumping, is covered by your policy.

Travel

From rail stations: Reading or Basingstoke (taxis from approximately £20.00).
From airports – London Heathrow (rail-coach link to Reading Rail Station) or Gatwick. We can arrange collection and delivery to airports or Eurostar trains, see rates above.

Additional costs & personal valuables

All evening activities are included in the price of the residential holiday. Pocket money to cover confectionery, telephone calls, gifts etc. is required and £20.00 cash per week should be sufficient. Additional pocket money is advised for those staying over the weekend to cover any personal shopping and entrance fees required. All cash and valuables (passports, airline tickets etc.) will be made secure on arrival. Please ensure all personal items are clearly labelled. **Mobile phones and computer games must be left at home! We cannot take responsibility for any lost property. Any mobile phones brought by the children will be secured in the main office, without exception.**

Shop

Our saddlery and clothing shop stocks most essentials for horse and rider including safety hats and body protectors (body protectors are advisable for jumping, and essential for those wishing to ride cross-country). These can be ordered by parents in advance. Parents may wish to authorise us to charge their credit card for ordered items or for additional articles selected from our shop while children are here. This reduces the amount of cash children need to bring. Items will only be charged once goods are received by the client.

Cancellation

Wellington Riding reserves the right to cancel bookings for any reason beyond our control, in which case all monies paid will be refunded.

In the event that guests have to cancel, notice must be given in writing more than four weeks prior to the start date of the holiday, the deposit payment will be retained.

In the event that guests have to cancel within four weeks of the start date of their holiday, fees are due in full and no monies will be returned (see insurance above). If guests wish to change the date of their holiday, notice must be given in writing at least four weeks before the start date of the holiday. We will endeavour to find and offer another available and acceptable date within the current year. If such alternatives cannot be accepted within the current year, all payments will be retained to defray costs of the cancellation (see insurance above.) An administration fee of £25.00 will be charged for each change made. Failure to provide required notice in respect of cancellations or changes to holidays will result in all monies being forfeited.

Discipline and Responsibility

Living alongside and mixing with other children is a valuable part of the holiday experience and we try to ensure that everyone is included. Every child wishes to enjoy their holiday and we keep a close check on teasing, bullying or any other anti-social behaviour that may spoil an individual's enjoyment. Our experience over the years means this is rarely a problem, but please tell your children that they must speak to an Instructor or Supervisor if this should occur. If your child informs you of a problem, please do not hesitate to contact the office so that we can take immediate steps to remedy the situation. When necessary, we will be firm with children who are jeopardising the enjoyment of others. If problem behaviour is persistent or serious we will contact the parent or guardian. We reserve the right to send any child home immediately at parent/guardian's expense and to charge for any additional costs incurred. No refunds will be made for any children sent home for behavioural reasons.
