Wellington Riding reserves the right to change a coach if necessary.

At Wellington we aim to provide enjoyable, progressive tuition for children of all riding abilities. Children may start to ride from the age of 5 years.

For beginner children we offer tuition on a one-to-one basis in half hourly sessions. These 'half hour privates' are designed to introduce children to riding basics and to prepare them to move into a group. Sessions may be booked Tuesday – Sunday 9am – 5pm, subject to availability. Once children are becoming comfortable and confident on their ponies, we recommend they move into a Falabella riding group. Lessons are assisted (with leaders if necessary), last for 1 hour, and comprise of a group of up to 6 children of similar ability. Times for these group sessions can be found above. Children who have ridden before should attend an initial one-to-one half-hour assessment. During this session the Instructor will teach the child whilst assessing them for a suitable group. Once children have joined a group assessment is ongoing, and their regular instructor will advise those riders who are ready to progress to the next level.
