Wellington Riding Membership

Wellington Riding runs a membership scheme which enables members to benefit from discounted rates for tuition and show entries. We also send you regular show information and schedules as well as offering advanced information on clinics, lessons and holidays.

Membership has been available from 1st October 2006 and is renewable annually.

Benefits include:

- Discounted lesson prices (see below)
- Discounted show entries on all Wellington Riding events
- Discounted hire of facilities e.g. arena hire
- Invitation to "members only" events, clinics, lecture demos etc. (min 2 per year)
- 10% discount in Wellington Riding Saddlery

Membership Rates For 2008/9

Adults: Renewal - £85.00 plus new member joining fee of £15

Juniors: Renewal £65.00 * plus new members joining fee of £10

*Junior rates apply to those under 16 yrs on 1st October each year.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

Special discount rate of 15% applies. Family membership equals 3 or more members of the same family (parent and children or brothers and sisters).

Adult Family Membership: £72.25

Junior Family Membership: £55.25

(For Example: 1 adult and 2 children = £77.25 + £55.25 + £55.25 = £187.75 per year.

Terms and Conditions

Bookings may be made in person daily between 9.00am & 5.00pm or by telephone between 9.00am & 1.00pm. Payment must be made in full at time of booking for all lessons. **Refunds are not given.**

VISA, Mastercard, Switch, Delta, Electron and Solo cards are accepted over the counter or by telephone. Bankers cards must be presented with cheques.

Bookings may be transferred to an alternative date provided that notice is given by noon on the previous day. If appropriate notice is not given, cancellation will occur without transfer. **N.B. A booking may not be transferred more than once.**

Bookings for weekend lessons close at 1.00pm on Fridays. We will endeavour to contact those on a waiting list should any cancellations occur.

We reserve the right to change an instructor if necessary. In every circumstance we will endeavour to notify clients of such changes.

Sets of 5 lesson vouchers are available at a reduced rate and may be used for group or ½ hour private beginner sessions. Normal transfer arrangements apply.

10 week terms of group lessons start at set dates 5 times a year, and are available at a reduced rate. Sessions booked by 10 week term are strictly non-transferable once booked. Bookings may be made over the counter or by telephone.

Prices for 10 Week Terms can be found above. Advantages of booking a 10 week term are that you receive 10 lessons for the price of 9 and can guarantee a place in a group lesson for the duration.

Riders on their own horse receive a 20% discount on group and private tuition.

A Senior Instructor is BHSII, BHSI or above.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Clothing Standards

Hard Hats (to current BHS requirements) and suitable footwear must be worn; footwear must have a smooth sole and a defined heel; shoes with buckles, platform or ribbed soles or high heels will not be permitted. Body protectors are strongly advised for jumping and mandatory for cross country.

Hard Hats can be hired at a small charge. Regular clients are expected to wear correct riding attire.

Group discount

Group discount is given to bone-fide schools or clubs with minimum of 6 riders, riding Tuesday to Friday.

New clients

All new clients at Wellington Riding are assessed in a half-hour private lesson. They must complete a client details form on booking their first lesson.
(All information received shall remain private and confidential).

Weather

We expect to ride in most conditions and appropriate clothing should be worn.

Weight restriction

To maintain a high standard of horse welfare it is necessary for us to impose an upper weight restriction on riders. Please contact reception for further details.

Closed

Wellington Riding is closed for lessons all day Monday, except for courses and holidays.

Wellington Riding Saddle Club

The club is run by and for our adult clients. The Saddle Club organises a calendar of competitions and events throughout the year. Please contact Reception for details and an application form.

Wellington Riding Pony Club

Non-pony owning junior clients can become members of our Centre Pony Club, which organises a calendar of competitions and events throughout the year. Please contact reception for details and an application form.
