Livery Service

At Wellington Riding we offer a full livery, and competition livery service. Each service has different benefits and is designed to suit the requirements of our individual livery owners. In our large complex we have a yard and team of staff solely dedicated to our livery horses and owners. Please find enclosed an outline of each service offered.

Full Livery – What does this include?

Full Livery is suitable for those who wish their horses to be looked after each day by our staff. Each horse has their own groom designated to take care of their daily needs.

Horses on full livery may use the horsewalker and enjoy full use of the schools and other facilities if not in use by the riding school.

The price for full livery includes:-

- Wellington feed (does not include specialist feeds or supplements)
- straw bedding (additional charge for shavings or cushion bed)
- daily care (mucking out, grooming, turnout & catching, tack cleaning, trimming manes & heels).
- daily exercise in one of the following forms; horsewalker, lunge, hack, turnout or ridden in a staff lesson.
- supervision for farrier & vet visits for your horse.

Additional services available, for charges please see Livery Extras sheet:-

- tacking up
- plaiting
- clipping and full trimming
- washing
- shavings or cushion bed
- veterinary treatments
- show preparation

Summer Turnout

For full livery clients, 24 hour summer turnout, with the school horses, may be available from the start of May to the end of September, at a reduced weekly rate.

What is included?

- Full-time turnout
- daily health inspections out in field of feet, rugs, wounds etc
- roughage (if shortage of grass, Wellington will replace with hay)
- day box (this service is a box only with no bedding and must be skipped out after use by the owner)

Please note that no exercise, grooming, tack cleaning or hard feed is included with this service

Competition Livery – What's the difference?

Competition Livery is an exclusive livery service, which enjoys all the benefits of full livery with the additional services included:-

- specified riders to provide professionally schooling according to the needs of the horse
- shavings or cushion bed (2 bales per week included in livery cost)
- clipping and trimming
- tacking up
- plaiting and pre competition preparation

As part of the service we will liaise closely with you towards any competitions or other goals you have. Our instructors or your allocated groom will be able to discuss your horse's progress and assist you with any issues you may have.

Rugs during Summer

Please take away any rugs not in use over the summer period. Wellington now provides a washing and re-proofing service on request (please see Livery Extras price list for charges).

Payment of Services and Extras

For all livery clients, shoeing, veterinary & equipment repair costs are charged directly to livery owners. All livery horses are wormed every 6 weeks and the cost of this, along with any livery extras, treatment charges, veterinary supplies, laundry costs, or shop purchases on account will be added to your monthly bill in arrears.

Additional livery Benefits:-

All livery clients receive the following benefits:-

- free subscription to Wellington Riding Membership scheme
- discounted rates for lessons when riding their own horse
- discount from shop items excluding books
- allocated arena (subject to schedule)
