

Wellington Riding Terms & Conditions for Show Entries and Clinics

By signing an entry form or making an online entry via the Secure Online Entry System, you are accepting these terms and conditions and agree to abide by them.

Conditions of Entry

1. Any individual class may have specific entry requirements, special conditions or notes and these will be listed on each schedule in the "Narrative" or "Special Conditions" sections.
2. Membership - Competitions are open to both members and non-members of Wellington Riding. Membership must be in the name of the rider and not the owner. Membership runs from 1st October annually and not from the date of joining. Please see schedule for members' entry fees or ask the Show Secretary for more details and an application form.
3. All Dressage competitions will be held under current British Dressage (BD) rules, unless otherwise stated and all Show Jumping competitions shall run under current British Show Jumping Association (BSJA) rules, unless otherwise stated.
4. All entries or bookings must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees, paid either by Secure Online Entry System using credit/debit card, by cash or by cheque made payable to "Wellington Riding". **Please note that from 1st April 2009, Wellington Riding will no longer accept show and clinic entries by cheque with the exception of Premier League and Area Festival entries.**
5. No refunds are given after close of entries. Withdrawals must be made in writing before close of entries and will be subject to a 50% refund or the entry may be transferred to another show date
6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry, cancel or amend any section, class, arena or show as they deem necessary without explanation. If weather conditions are extreme, please check in case of cancellation. The organisers will endeavour to inform competitors of any cancellations or amendments by telephone or on the website.
7. Dressage tests are from the current BD series and are available from BD on 02476 698 836.
8. For Dressage competitions entries may be limited and a waiting list will be kept and competitors will be informed of their position on the list when phoning for times or viewing their times on the website.
9. For Dressage competitions it is the competitor's responsibility to call for times as stated or to visit www.wellington-riding.co.uk to see the times online.
10. For Show Jumping competitions entries may be limited and are taken on a first come, first served basis. Waiting lists may be kept for oversubscribed classes. Times shown on the schedules are approximate and classes may start early or amended depending on the number of entrants.
11. For Unaffiliated Show Jumping classes, a "Junior" must be 16 years of age and under **AND** riding a pony 148cms (14.2hh) and under. A "Senior" is 16 years old & over riding a horse of any height **OR** a rider of any age riding a horse 14.3hh and over.
12. All competitors must ride in the declared order. If a competitor does not present themselves to the steward, or if the competition is self-stewarding, to the judge at the appropriate time, they will be deemed withdrawn.
13. The decision of the organisers and judge's is final. Any objections should be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes of the incident and supported by a £10 deposit, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
14. For Show Jumping competitions practice jumps must be jumped in the correct direction, white flag to the rider's left hand side and red flag to the rider's right hand side.
15. Lunging is not permitted in any of the arenas at any time during the competitions.

Health & Safety

16. Correct riding attire must be worn by all competitors unless stated otherwise. All competitors should wear a correctly fastened helmet to the current BSI Standards at all times when mounted on the show ground. Body protectors are compulsory for Cross Country events.
17. The health & welfare of horses and ponies attending events is essential. Any horse deemed to be sick or injured in any way will be immediately eliminated and the owner requested to remove them from the premises as soon as possible.
18. Flash photography is strictly forbidden. Mobile telephones must be turned off during dressage tests. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on site.
19. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and are the responsibility of the owner.
20. All horses or ponies, when outside the arena, should be moved at the walk only, to ensure the safety of all spectators and pedestrians.
21. Children under the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 yrs, who will be held responsible for their behaviour and welfare.
22. For safety reasons, the gate across the main driveway must be kept closed at all times.
23. In the interests of health and safety, everyone concerned with any entry must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser, judges or stewards including conduct in working-in and viewing areas. Anyone in breach of these terms and conditions may be asked to leave the site immediately.
24. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that organisers, the land-owner and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants, horses or ponies, how so ever caused and that each entrant agrees to indemnify them against and legal action arising there from.
25. The organisers reserve the right to amend these Terms and Conditions as necessary and current copies will be available at the venue or on the website as soon as they are available.
